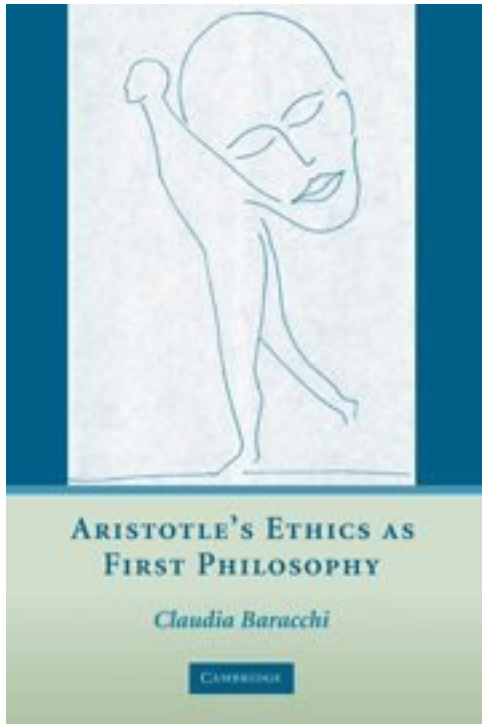

In *Aristotle's Ethics as First Philosophy*, first published in 2008, Claudia Baracchi demonstrates the indissoluble links between practical and theoretical wisdom in Aristotle's thinking.
