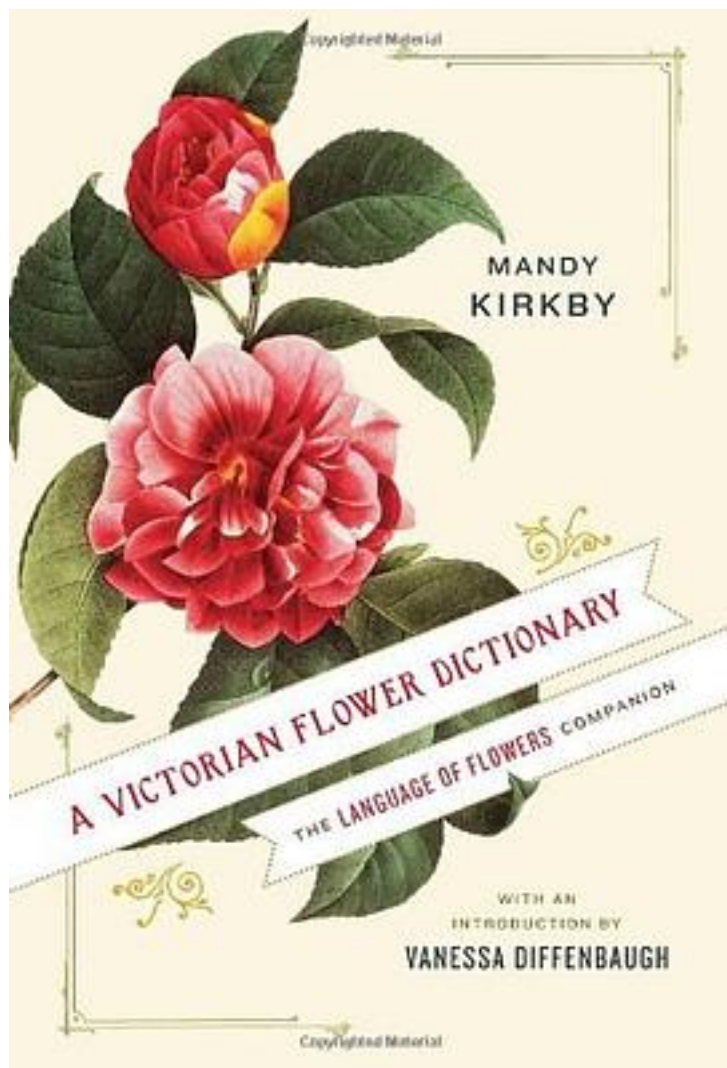


A Victorian Flower Dictionary
