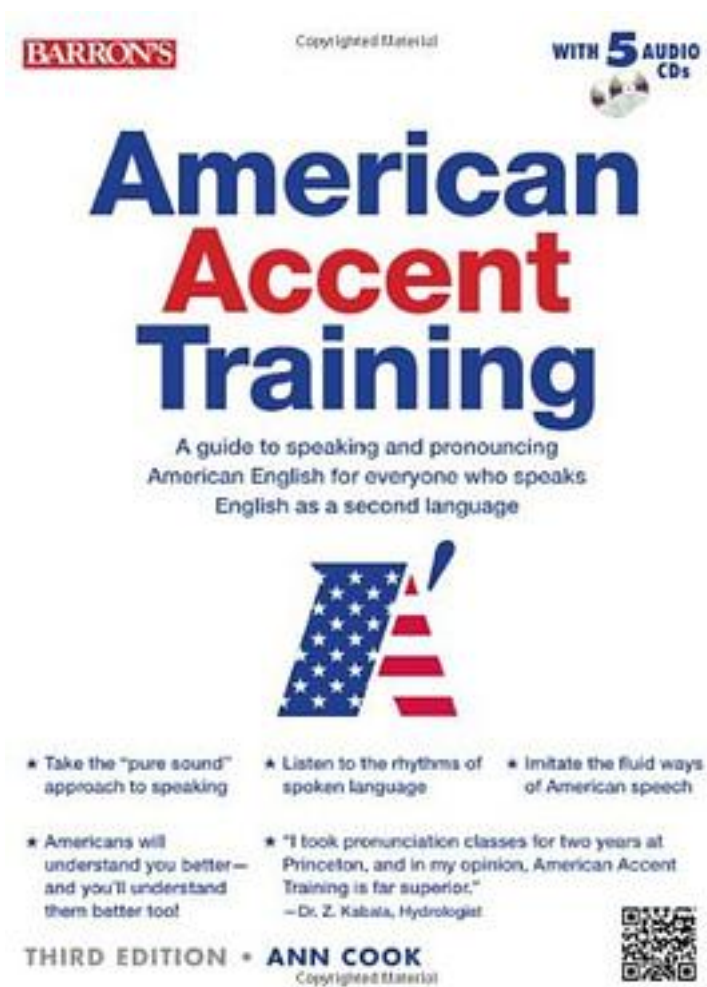


American Accent Training
