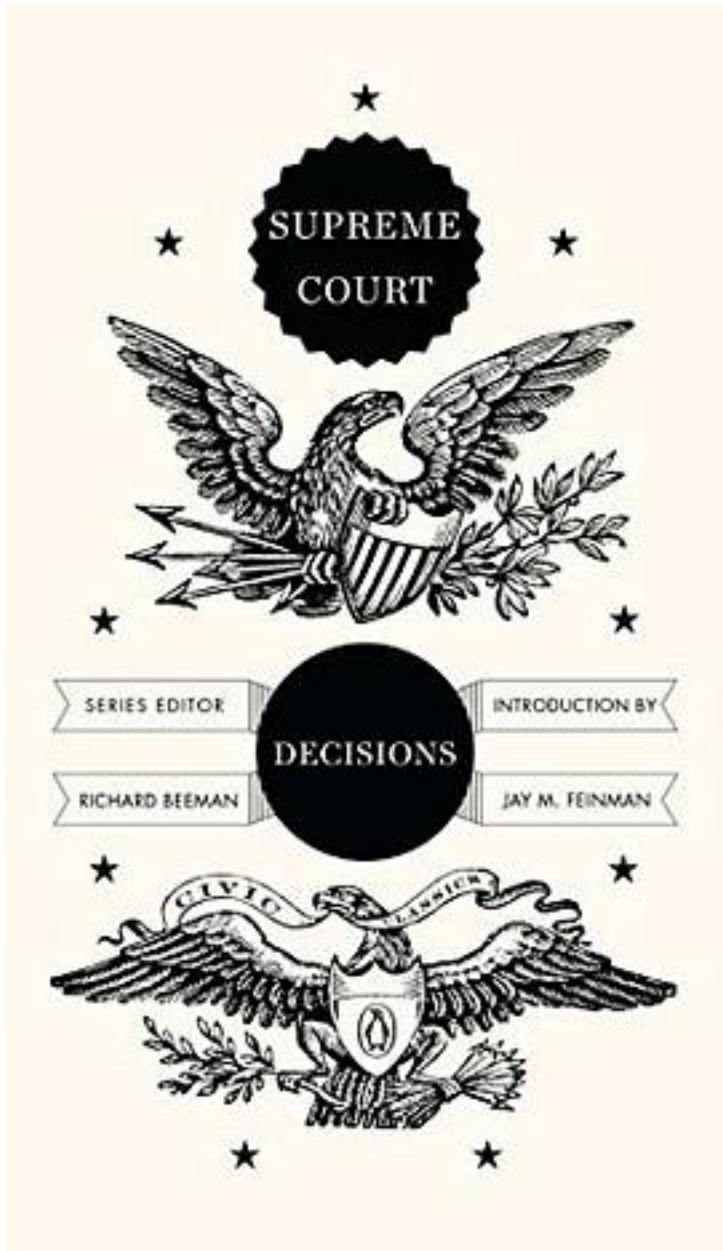

Rumsfeld*, a post-9/11 case on presidential power and due process.
