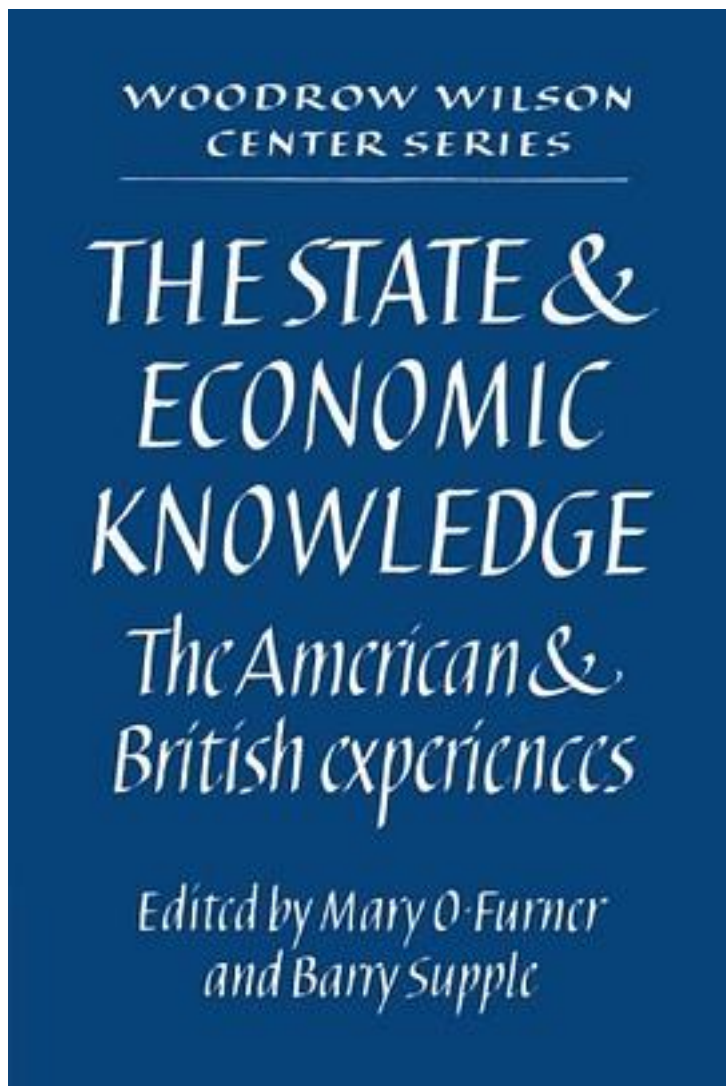

The approach is comparative, focusing on developments in modern Great Britain and the United States.
