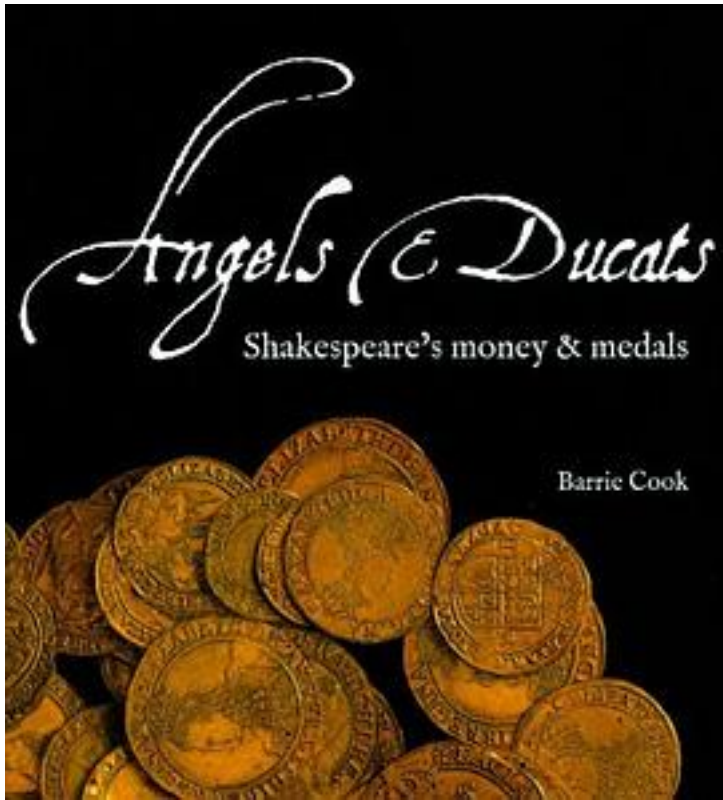


Angels and Ducats
