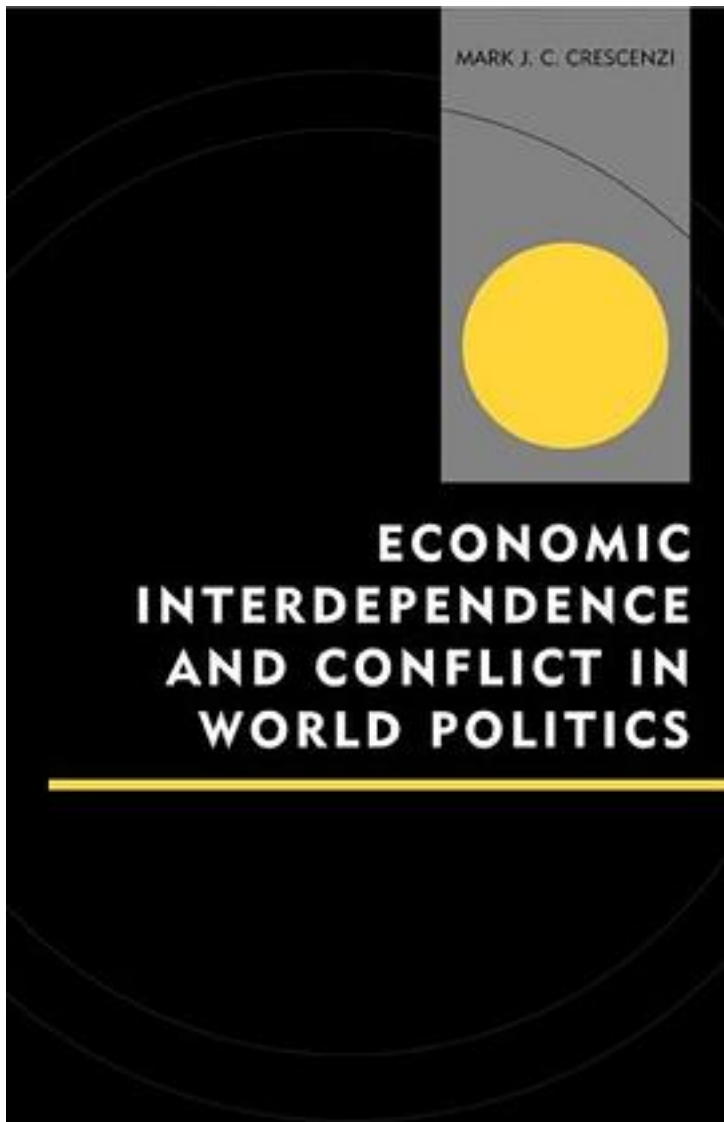


Economic Interdependence and Conflict in World Politics
