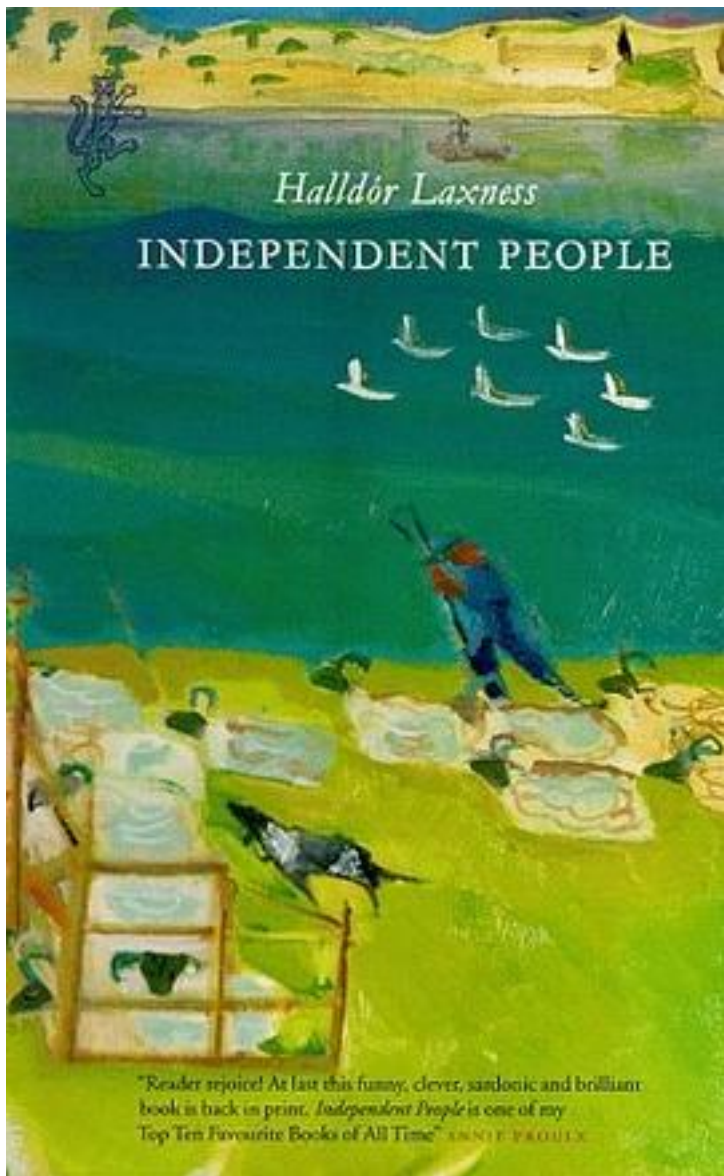

In 1955 he was awarded the Nobel Prize for Literature. He died in 1998.
