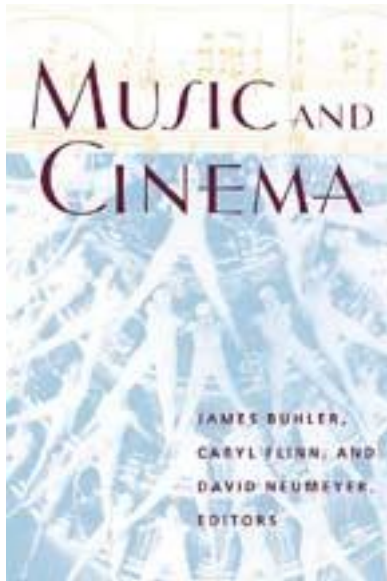


Music and Cinema (Music/Culture)
