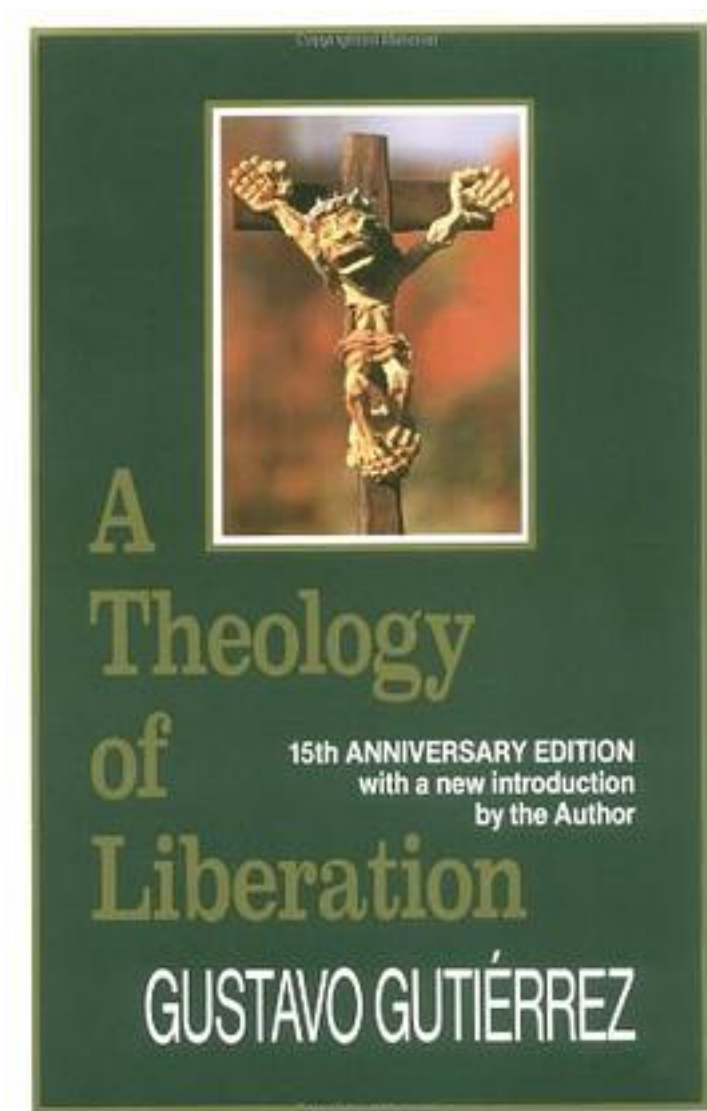


A Theology of Liberation
