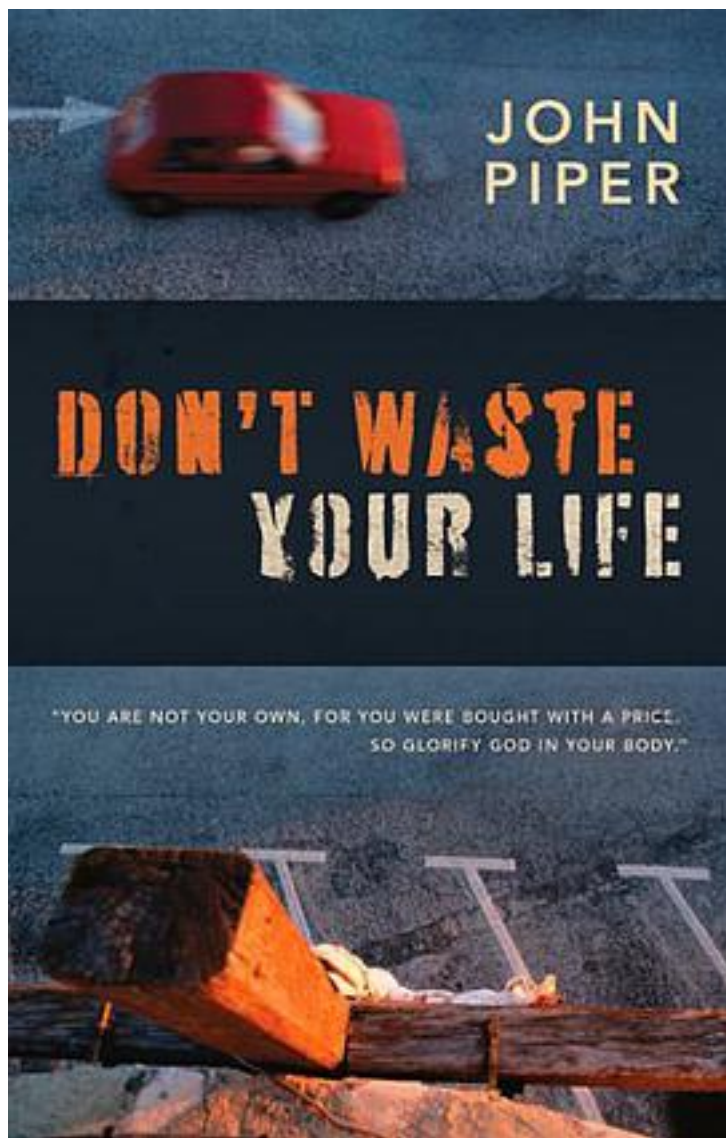


Don't Waste Your Life
