The pine tree, bamboo and plum blossoms, called the three winter companions by poets, convey connotations of eternal youth and vitality. The peaches, glossy skin and gourds, carried by the boys, swell as deities in patterns of fruit. The character at the bottom, of the picture, all symbolize longevity, happiness, position and achievement.
