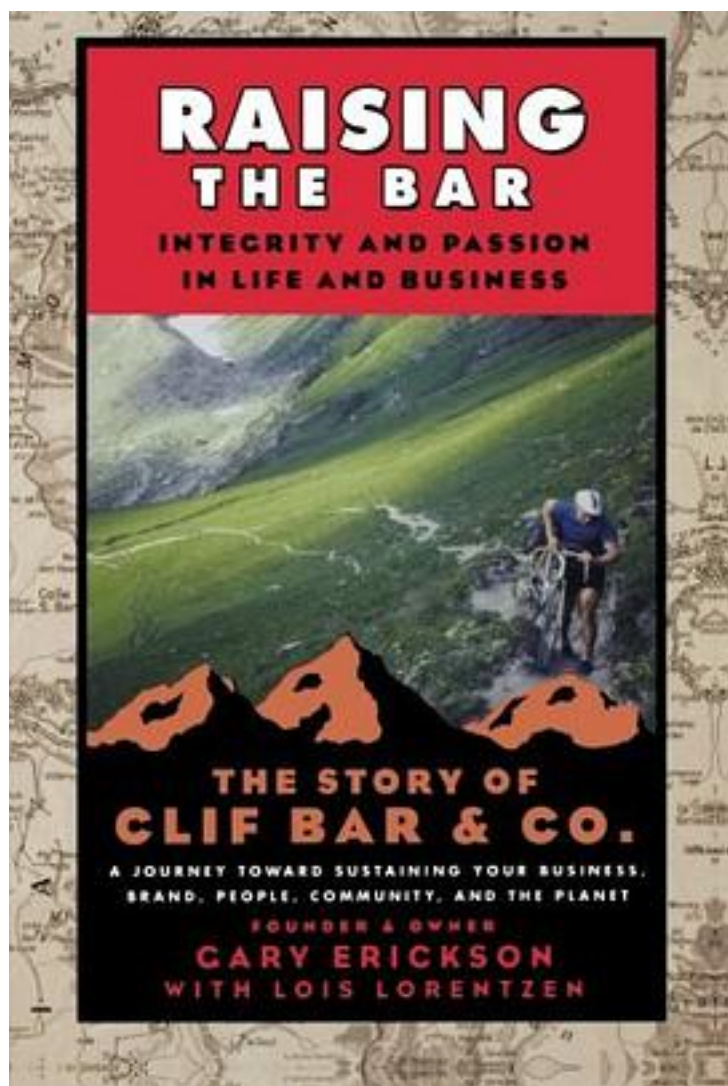


Raising the Bar
