

莫斯利的主旨其实很简单: the war of love, the sufferings, violences and impossibilities. 第一眼看上去故事似乎没有什么联系,只不过是一些重复的情绪、习惯和词句。主角大致可以说是第一个故事的男人和第二个故事的女人,但因为非线性时间的叙事和莫斯利没有给角色取名字,所以读起来会感到似是而非。爱情中的两人像是站在镜子里外,明明意图做同样的举动,但最终的结果是背道而驰。The opposites are infinite, love is impossible.

个人还挺喜欢的,莫斯利的遣词有时候太prosaic又有点上世纪英国贵族的腔调,否则大概会更喜欢。以及要拍电视剧的话应该很适合由Melrose的班底加索伦蒂诺执导。
