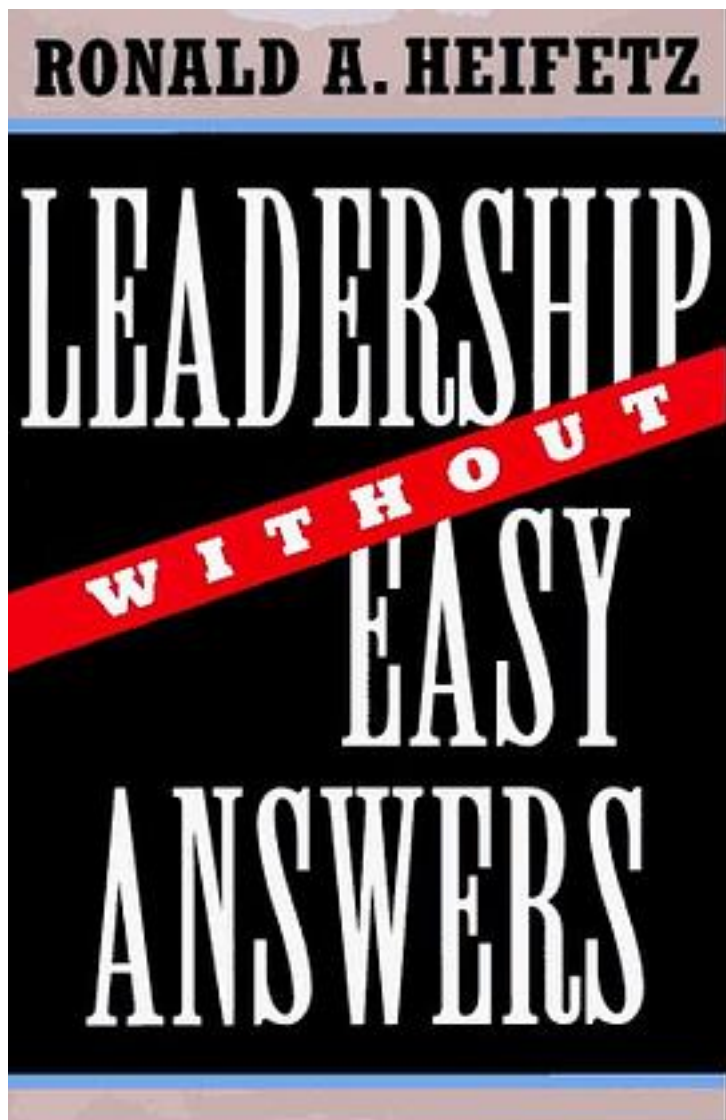


Leadership Without Easy Answers
