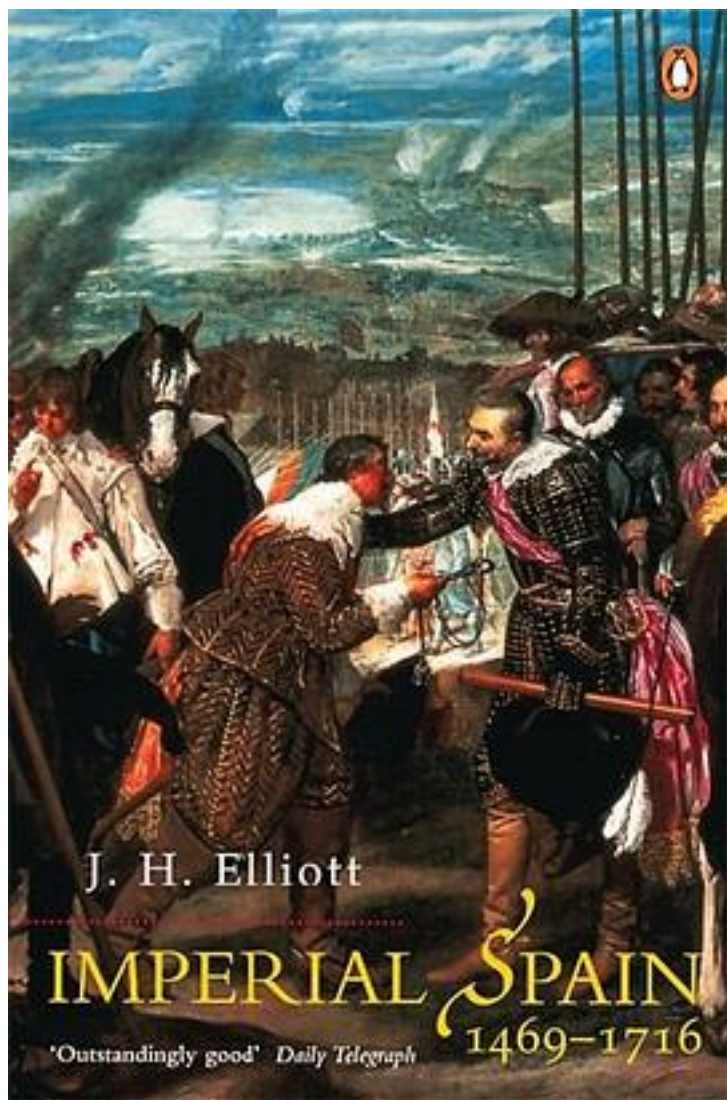


Imperial Spain
