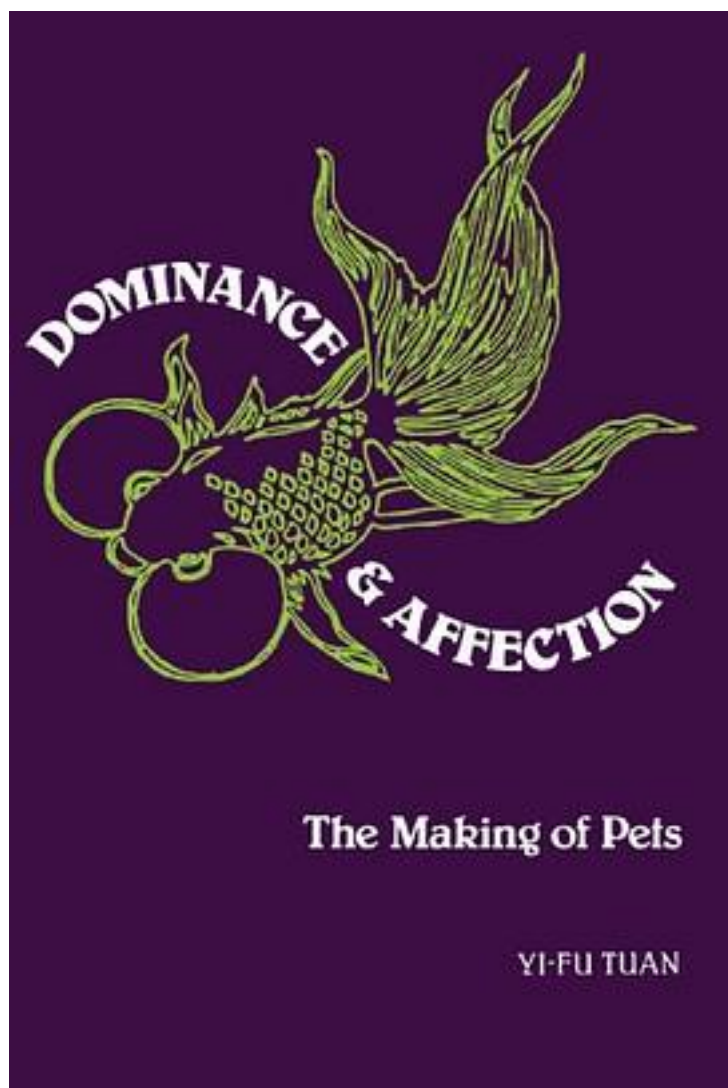


Dominance and Affection
