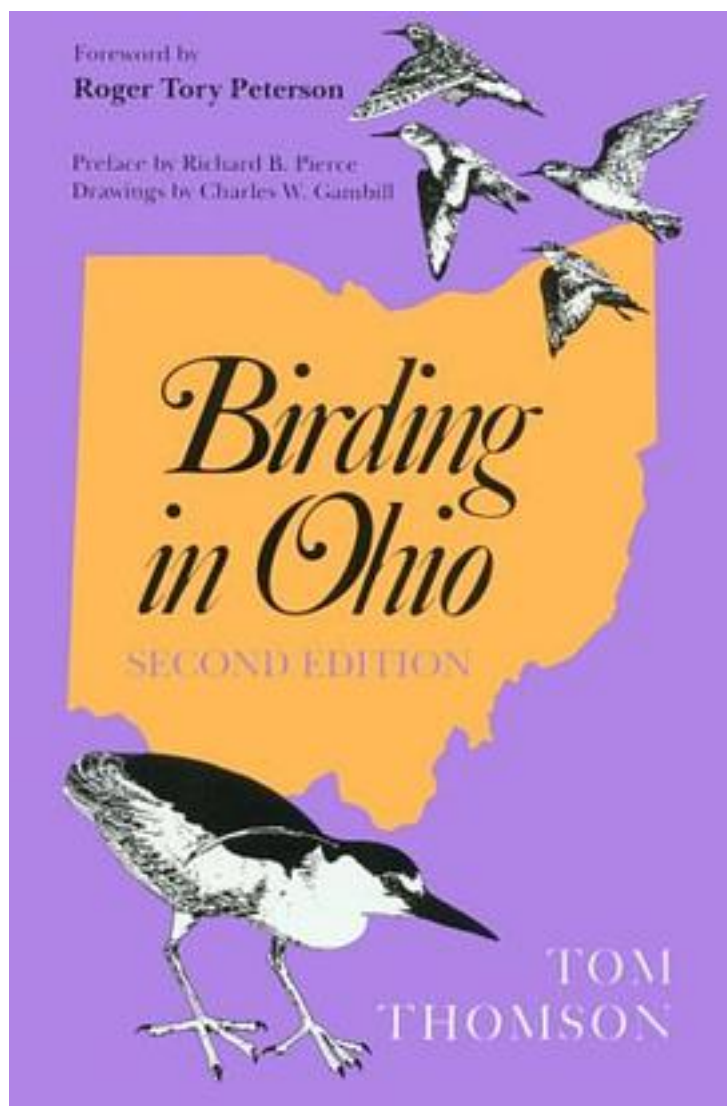

In each site description, the birds and seasons of particular ornithological interest are discussed in the greatest detail. Part four provides a checklist of the birds of Ohio, with symbols denoting geographical location, seasonal presence, and numerical status. Information is also included on birding and natural history organizations, taped rare-bird alerts, and related publications.
