With Mussolini's Italy, R.J.B. 将近10年前凑单买的，想不到后来真的会对这个主题发生兴趣。纯外行角度我觉得作者对材料很熟，但用得有点一厢情愿。副标题的野心最多只在前6章（1915-22，这部分还蛮好看的）实现了吧，后面就逐渐退化为罗列高度重复的宣传材料和police reports。这些主要用来讲regime由于复杂的形势统一以来各种遗留问题etc，以及其本身的incompetence，始终没能意识形态导向地影响意大利人的生活。但是regime到底怎样影响了意大利人的生活？虽然作者是反对Croce的parenthesis说的，但他的narrative最后反倒有点像是加强了这个说法。（本书毒舌起来还挺爽的，看多了意大利人油腻又尖刻的东西，英语作者冷峻的嘲讽不失为一种antidote吧。RSI和战后那两章疯狂吐槽就很过瘾。）
