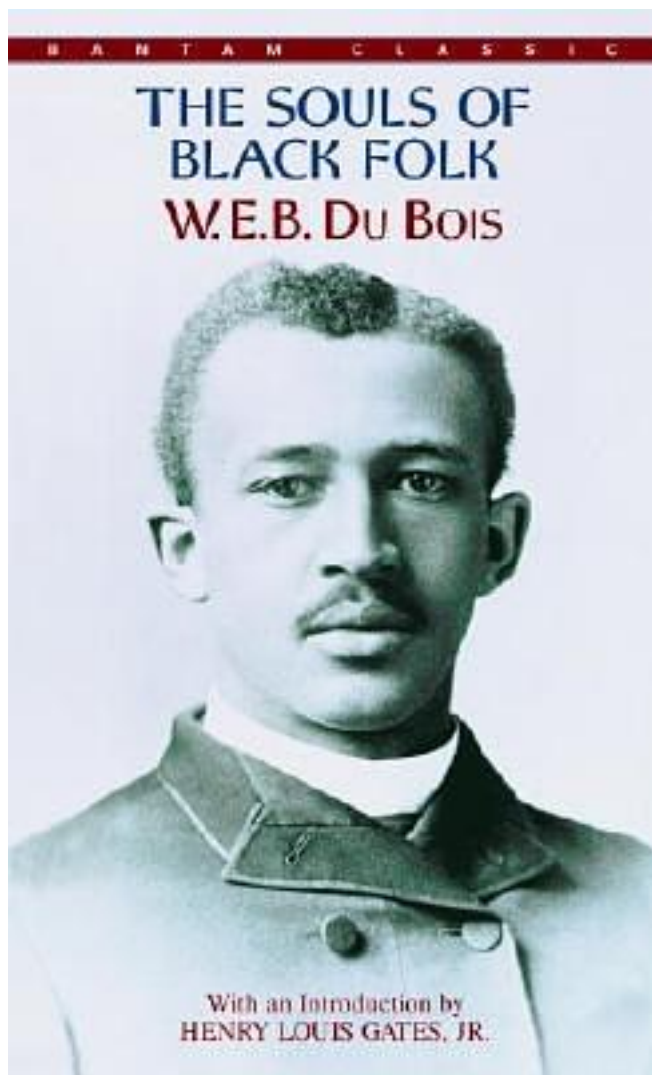

Published in 1903, *The Souls of Black Folk* by W. E. B.
