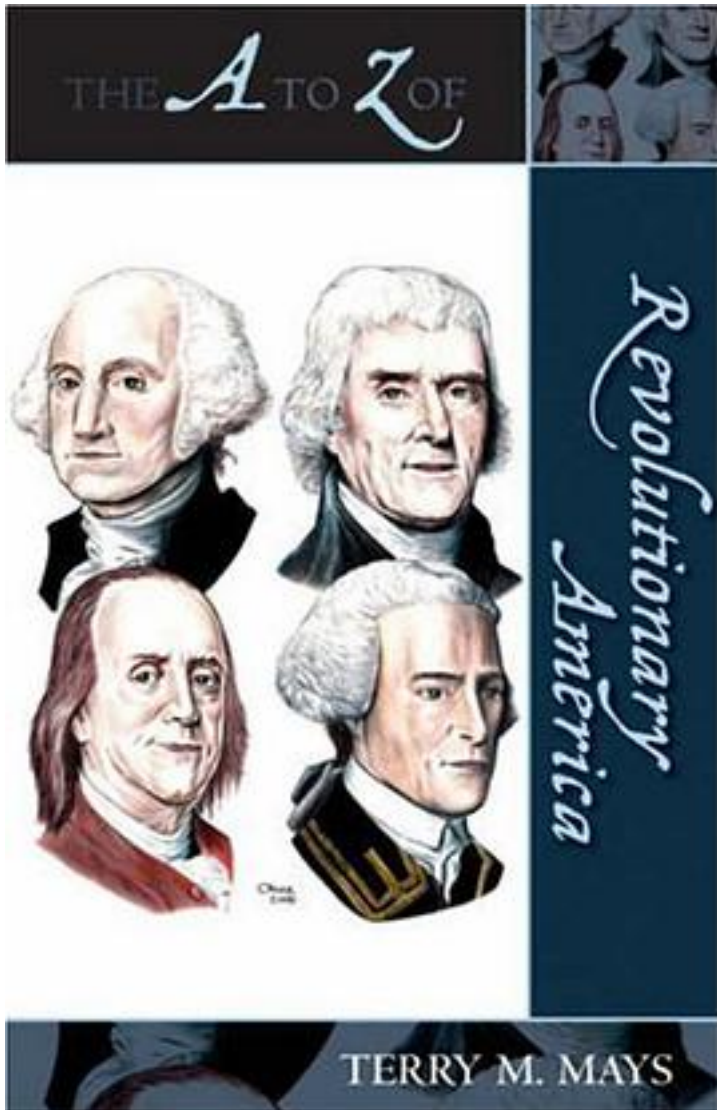

The American Revolution was one of the most significant events in modern history.
