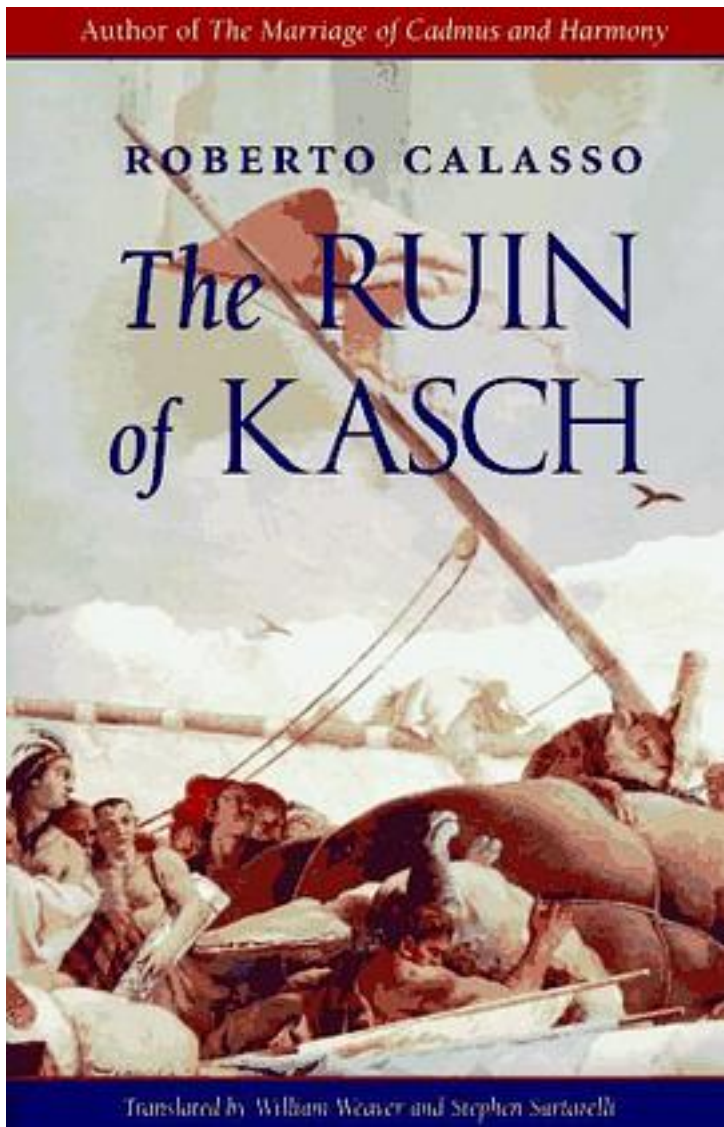

After a successful career in publishing he has become a leading intellectual.
