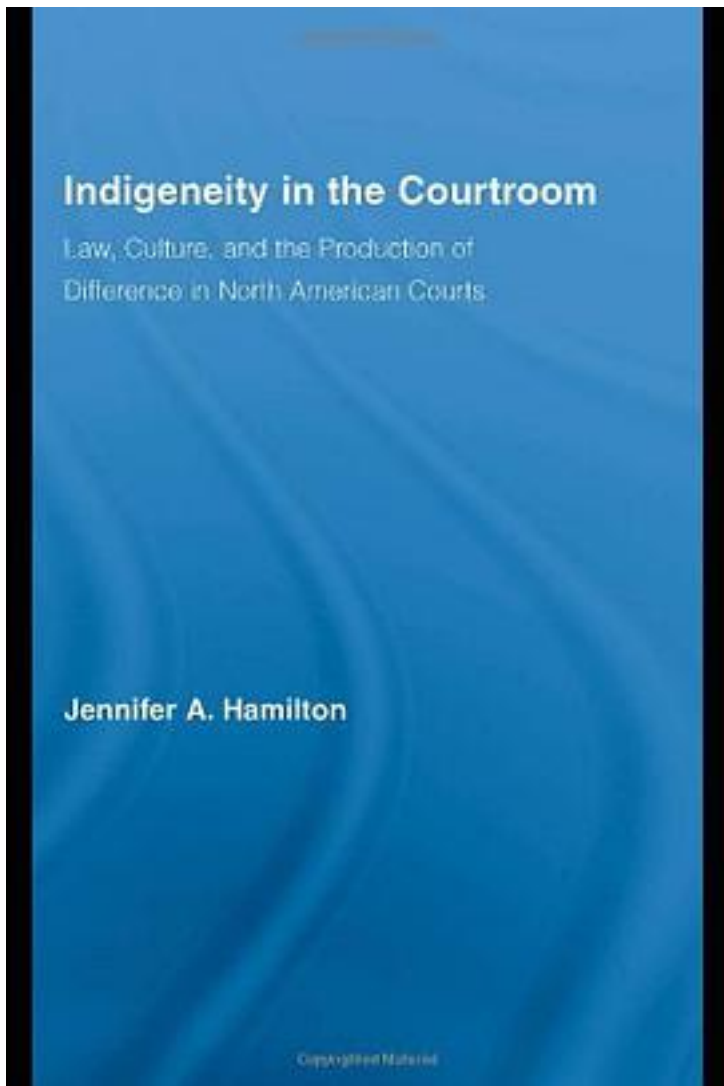

"Indigeneity in the Courtroom" focuses on the legal deployment of indigenous difference in US and Canadian courts in the late 20th and early 21st centuries. She looks at the realm of law, seeking to understand how indigeneity is legally produced and to apprehend its broader political and economic implications.
