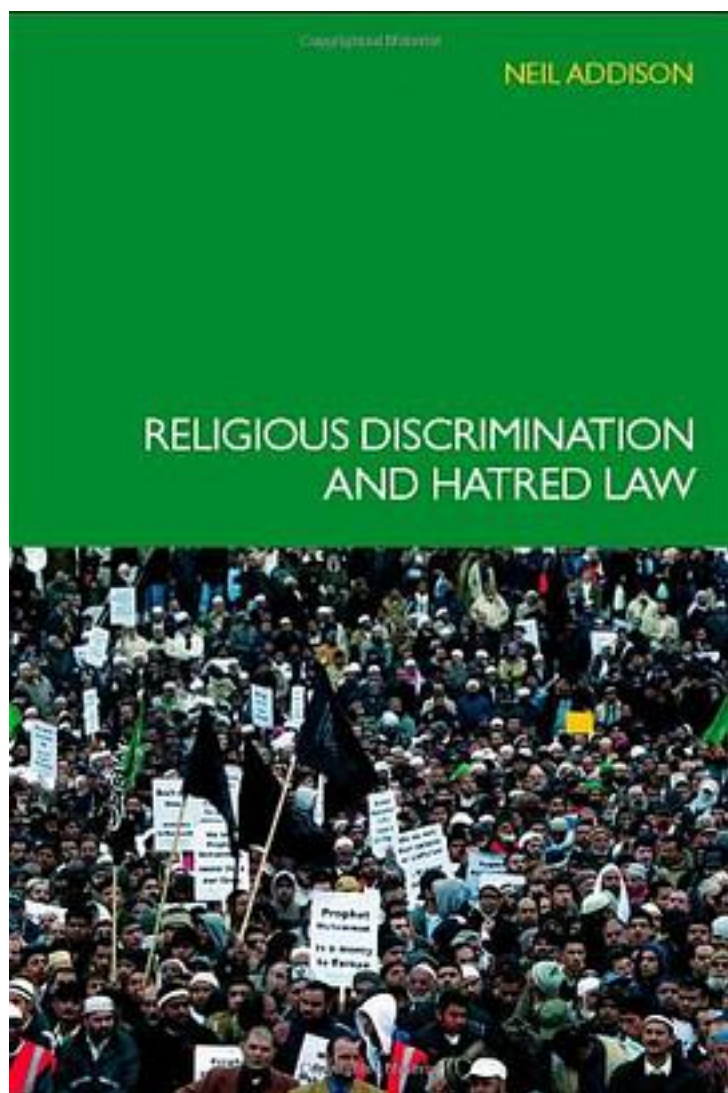


Religious Discrimination and Hatred Law
