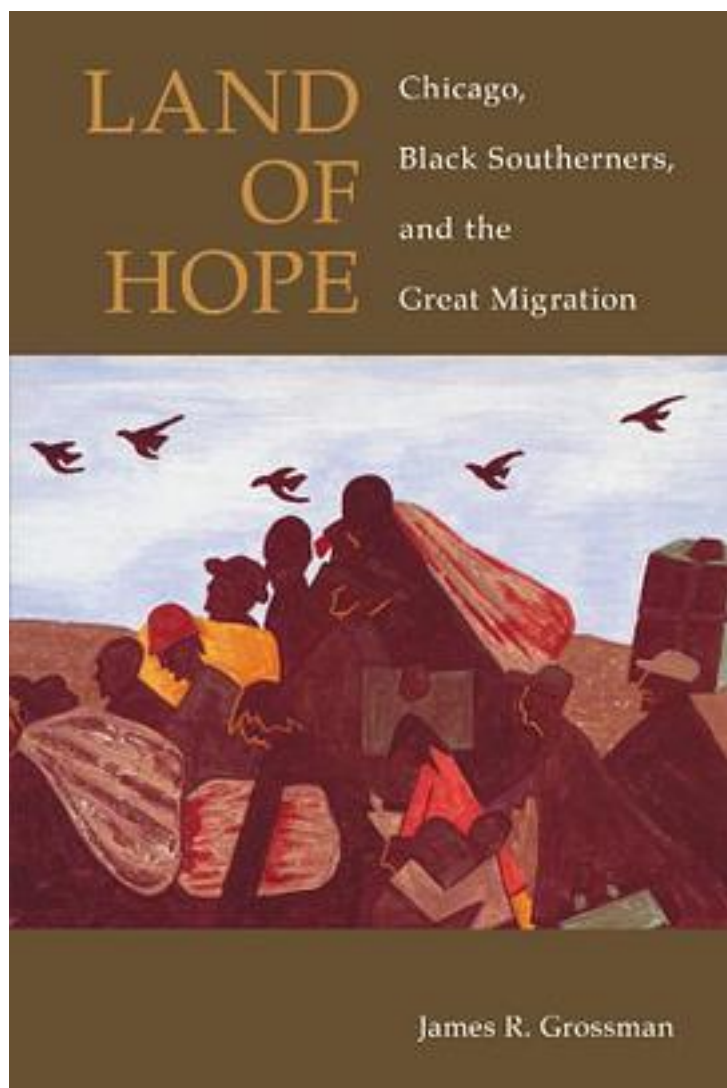


Land of Hope

史学家做研究太扎实了！一部真正从黑人角度记录20世纪初南方黑人北迁至芝加哥的历史。上半部一章谈黑人迁移的历史背景；二章谈南方白人的复杂反应与多重阻挠；三章谈推动迁移的关系网络（组织/领袖/个人）；四章谈北迁旅途的经历。下半部五章谈芝加哥的街区分划隔离，房屋短缺，原住与新迁黑人的冲突；六章谈种族关系歧视冲突；七章谈黑人面临的工厂体验与艰辛；八章分析工薪黑人为何反工会；九章谈北方的教育机会。全书最服气的是将黑人内部因阶级和地域区隔导致的分歧，同样无法统一态度的报社与组织领袖的矛盾解释的万分清楚。SY 8/22
