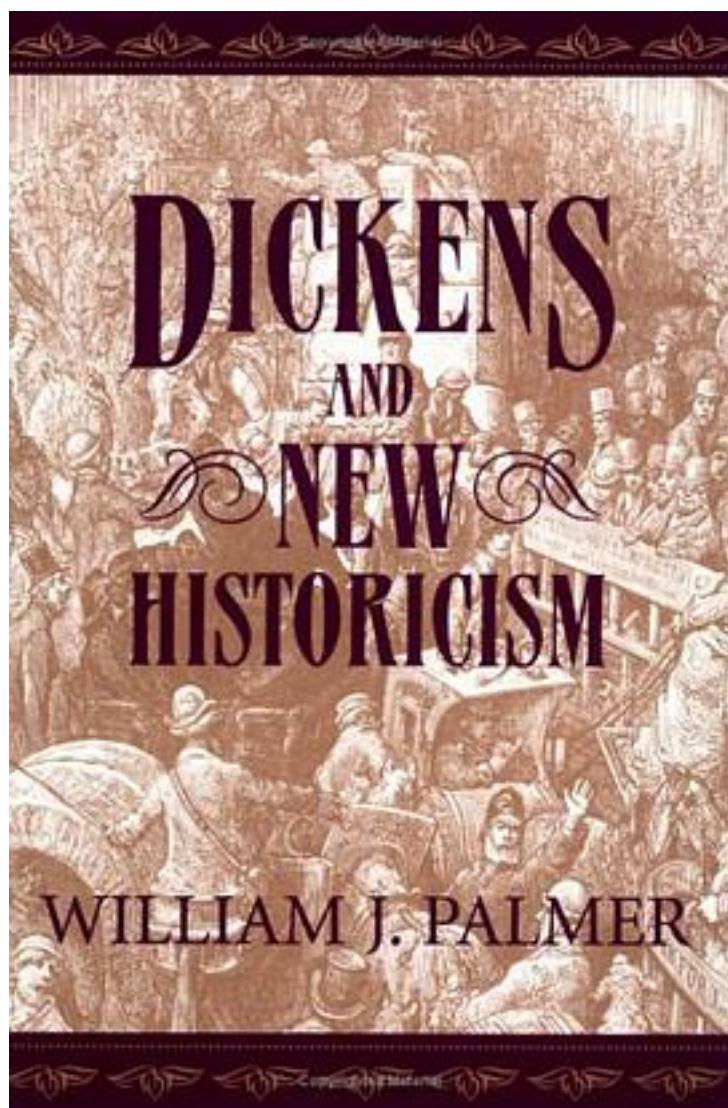

Throughout his work, Charles Dickens focused upon the definition, composition, and democratizing of the process of writing history. In *Dickens and New Historicism*, William J.
