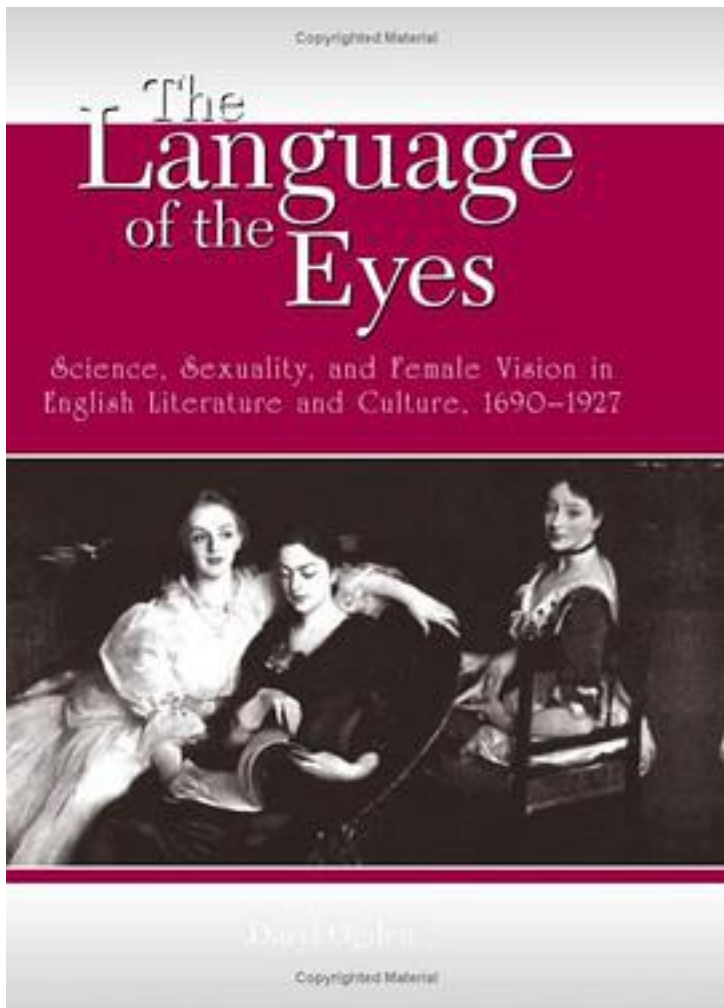

While Darwinian and Freudian theories of vision and sexuality have represented

In so doing, Ogden accomplishes what numerous feminist critics--especially film theorists--have not: the recovery of the modern female spectator from historical obscurity.
