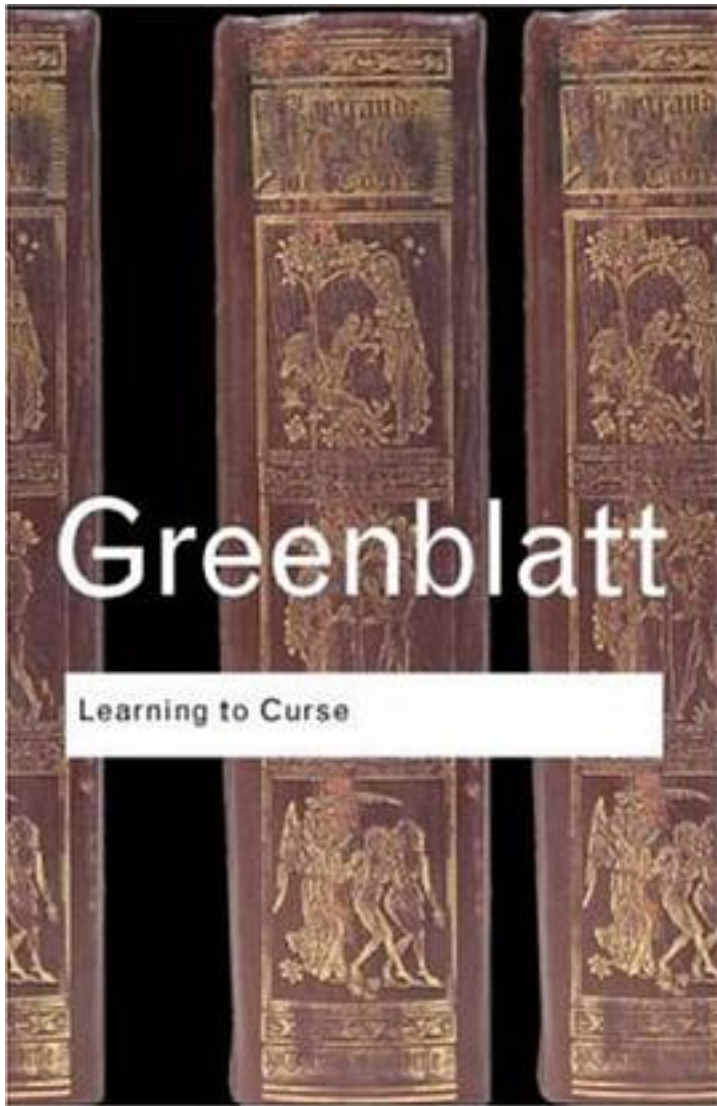


# Learning to Curse

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chap. 3 “Marlowe, Marx, and Anti-Semitism”

同是犹太人刻板刻画，笔者认为莎士比亚笔下的夏洛克完全不同于马洛（the Jew of Malta）和马克思(On the Jewish Question)笔下的犹太人。威尼斯全剧的戏剧冲突都围绕着犹太教财政主义（Jewish fiscalism）和非犹太教重商主义(Gentile mercantilism)展开。剧中的“局外人”夏洛克无论是语言使用/ 心理/ 种族/ 宗教上都不同于他人。他象征着“异”。但他也有趋同时刻——hath not a Jew eye? 需警惕这种“同”有如暗流贯穿全文。
