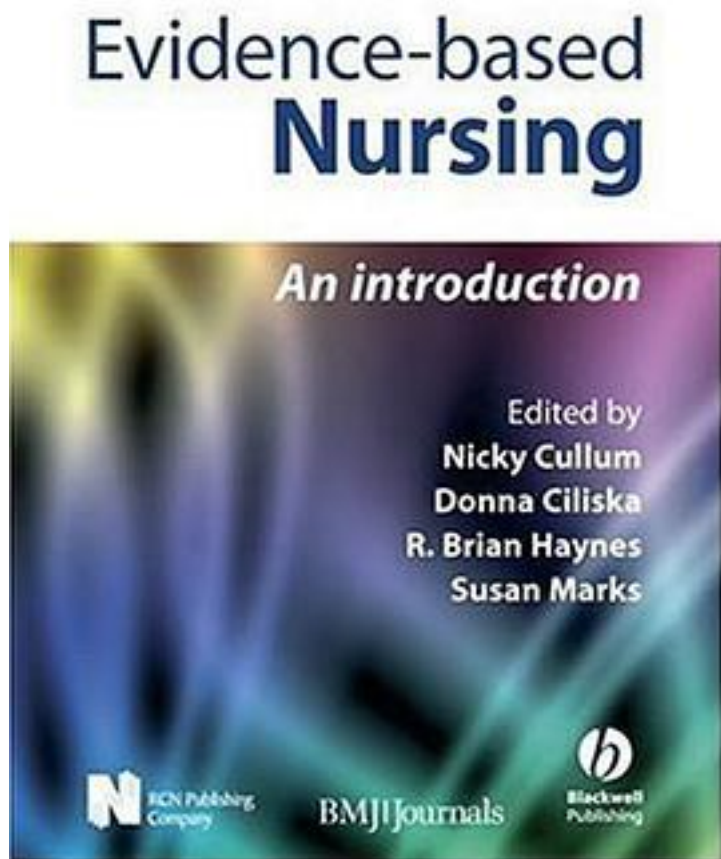


Evidence-Based Nursing
