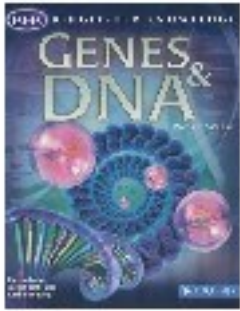


Genes and DNA
