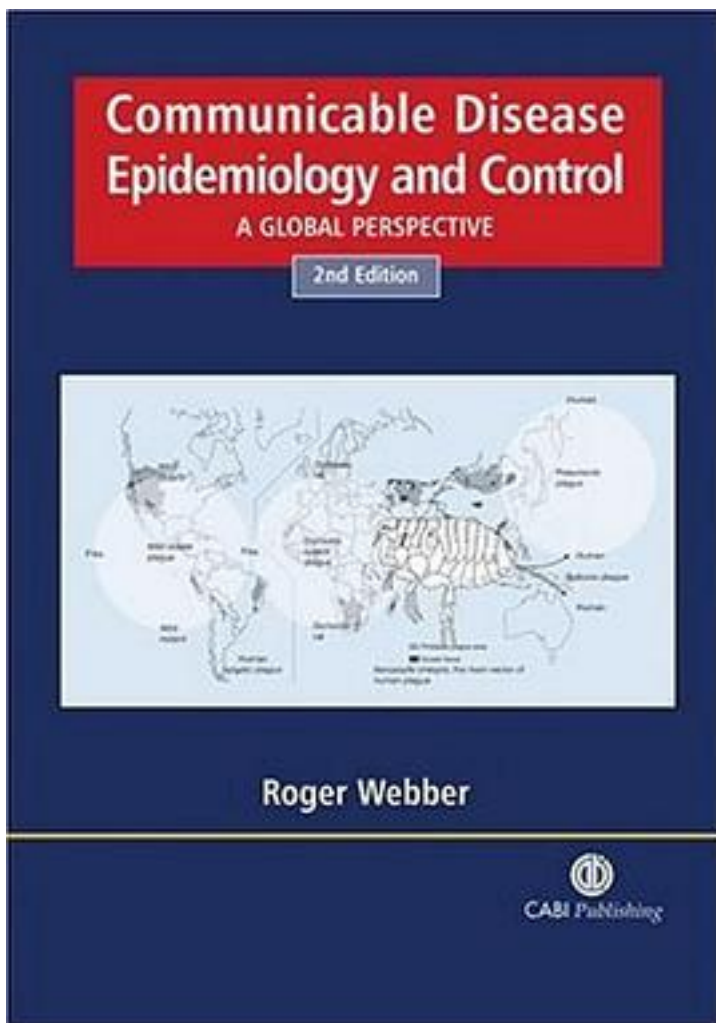


Communicable Disease Epidemiology and Control
