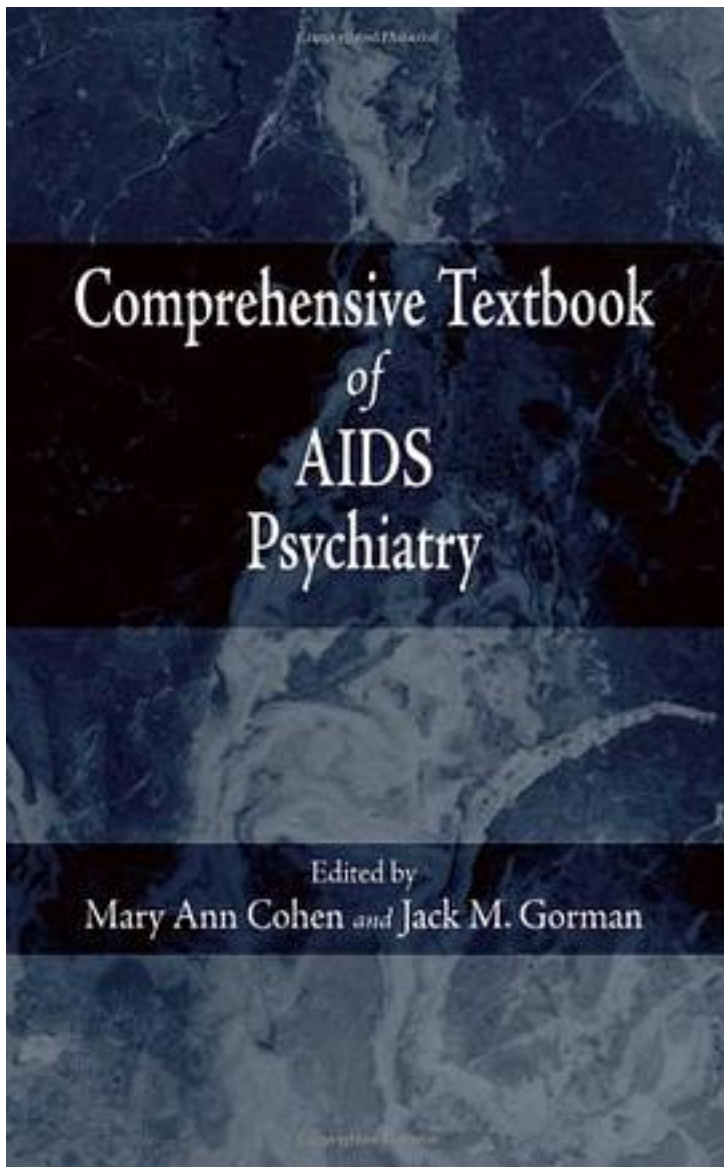


# Comprehensive Textbook of AIDS Psychiatry
