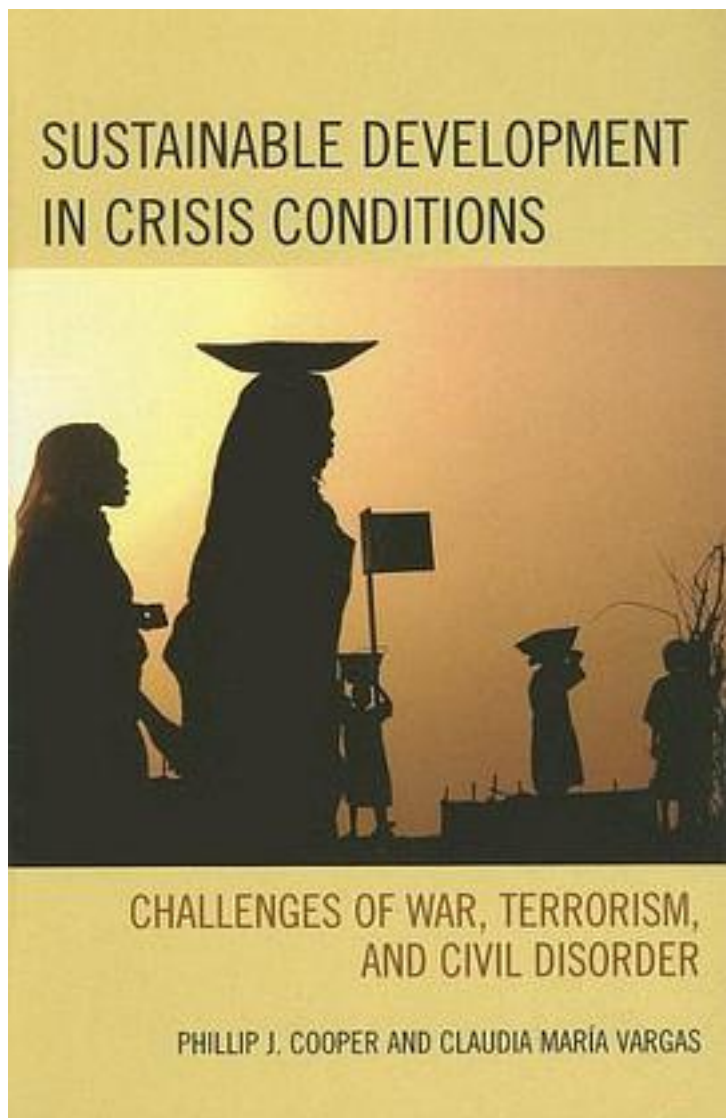


Sustainable Development in Crisis Conditions
