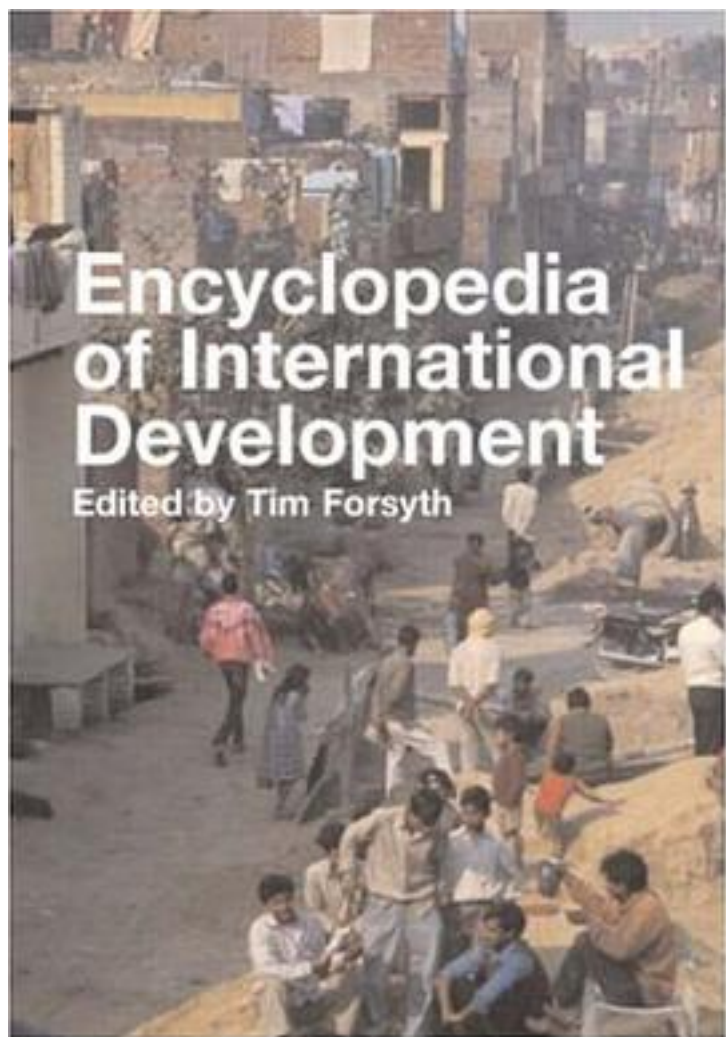

The "Encyclopedia of International Development" is a large-scale work that

Since the 1960s, most industrialized countries of Europe and North America have identified international development as a routine part of government policy. Today, the practice of international development is still growing and also becoming more complex as more and more countries engage in development, and international development addresses an ever-larger range of activities. Furthermore, many non-governmental and private sector agencies are now also emerging to undertake development work in addition to government bureau. This growth has been matched by an increase in academic research into the subject as a mounting number of universities offer degree courses in international development.
