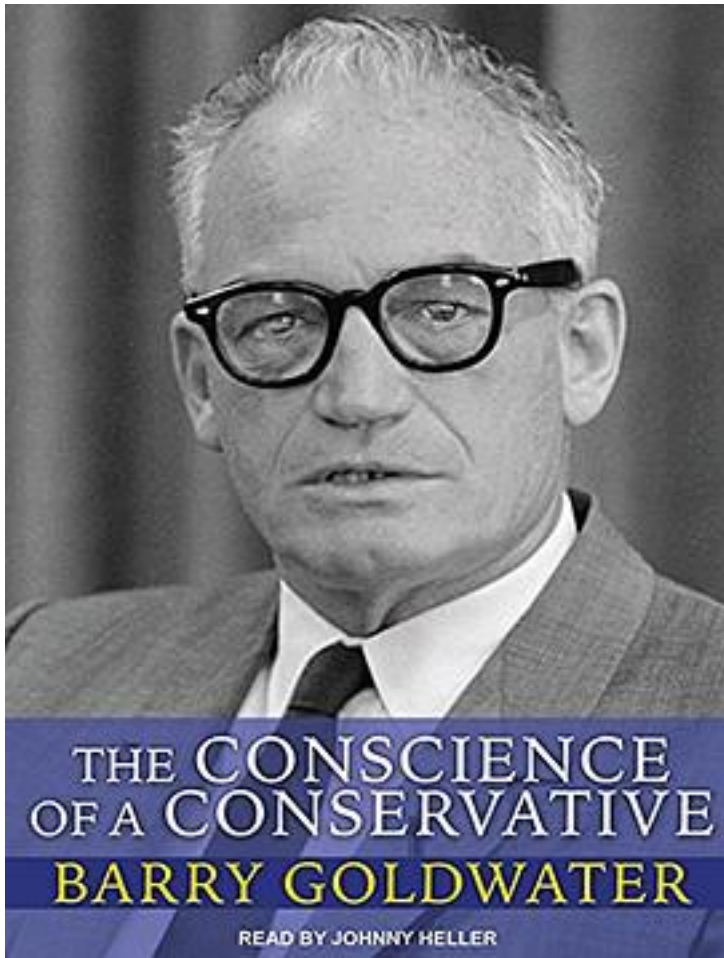


The Conscience of a Conservative
