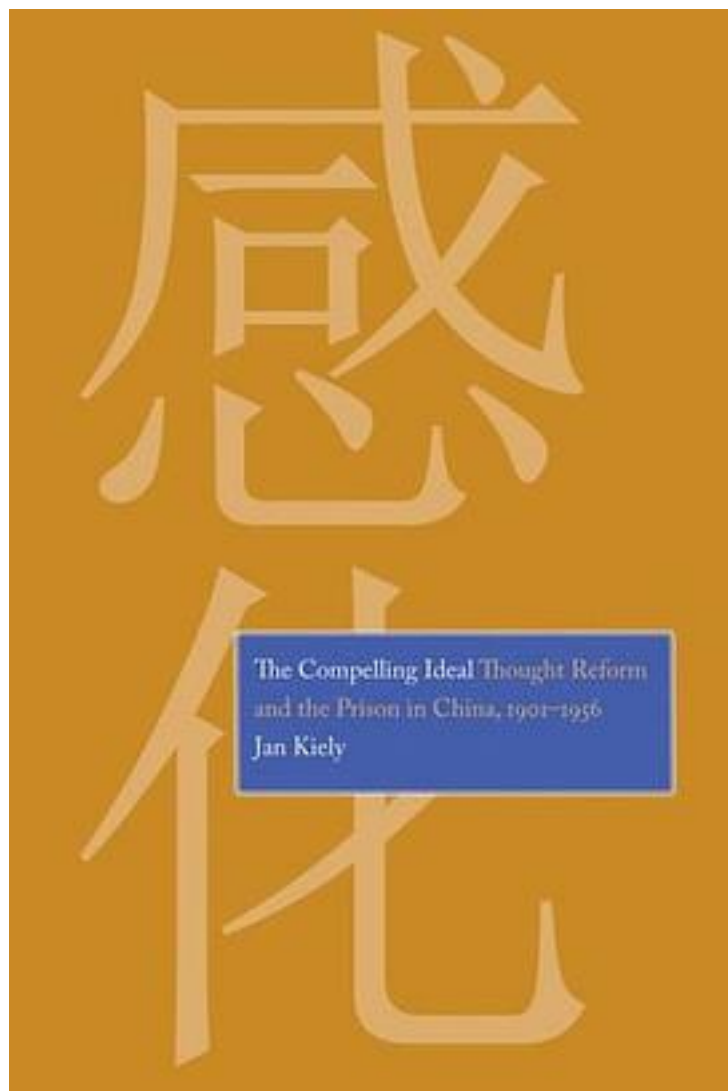


The Compelling Ideal
