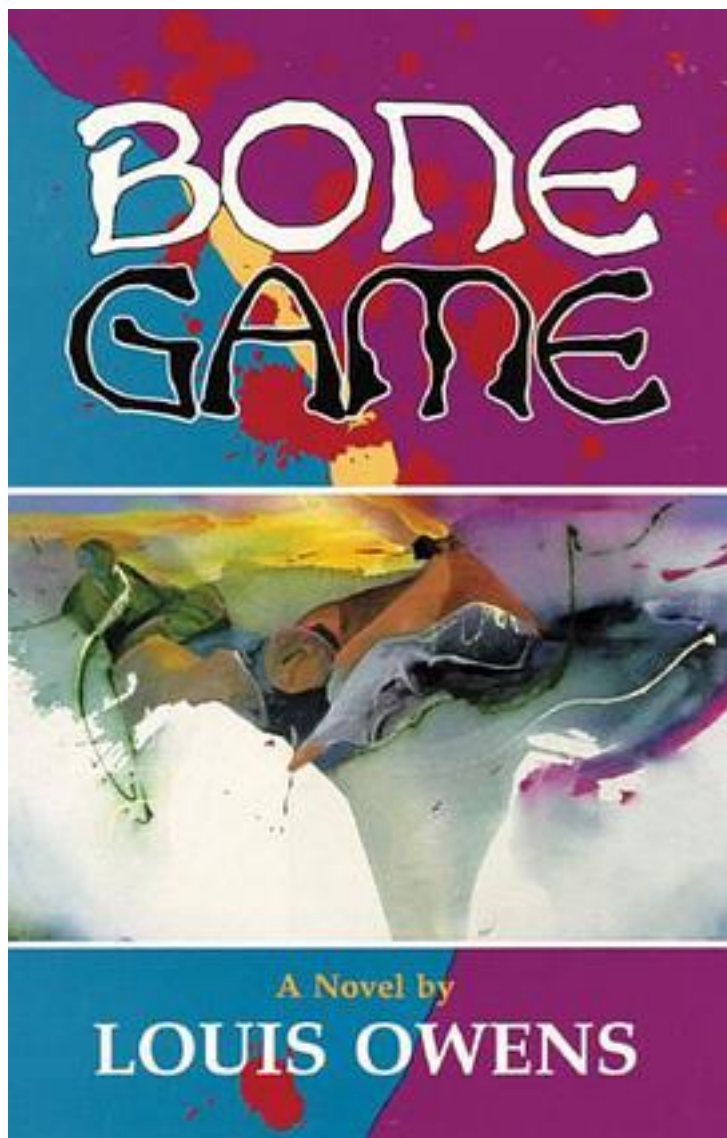

Bone Game is a murder mystery on a grand scale.
