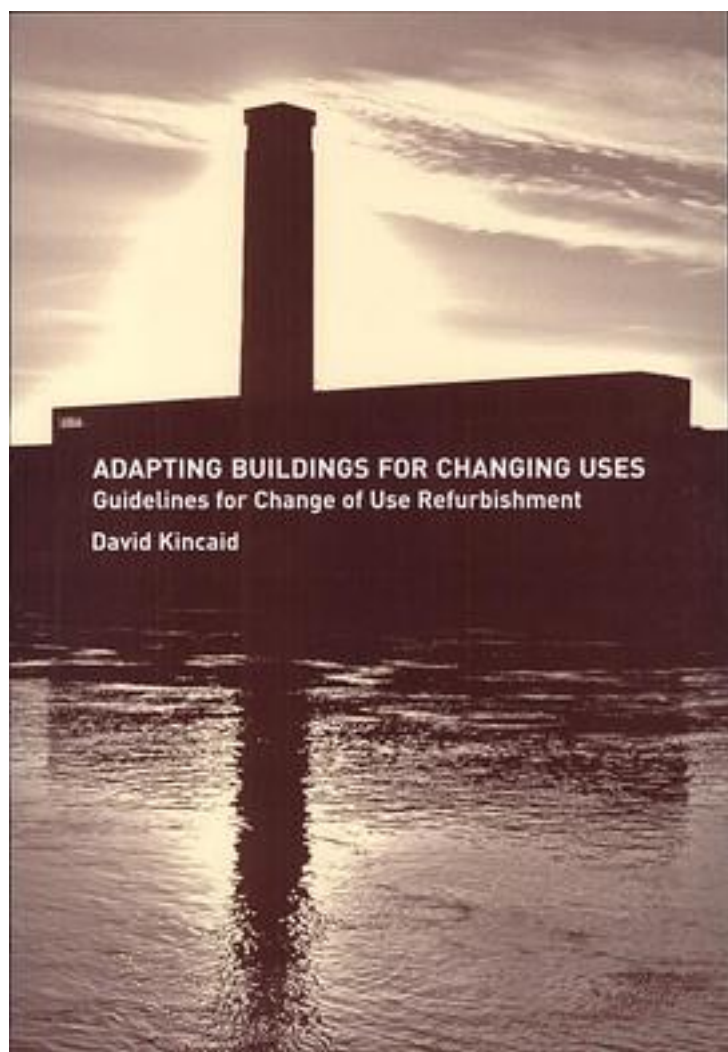


Adapting Buildings for Changing Uses
