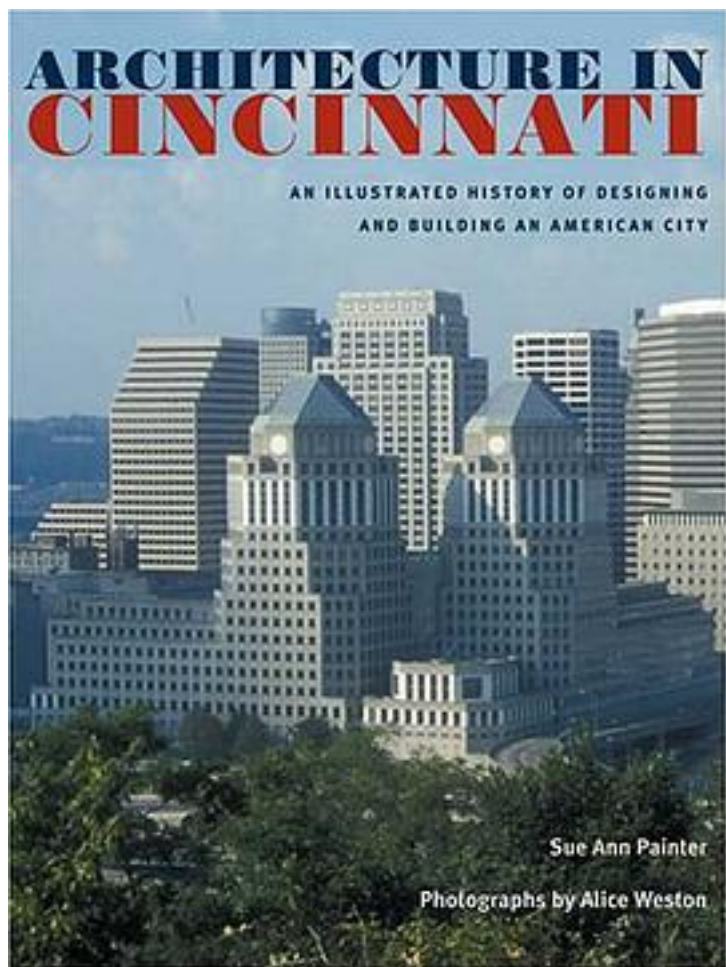


Architecture in Cincinnati
