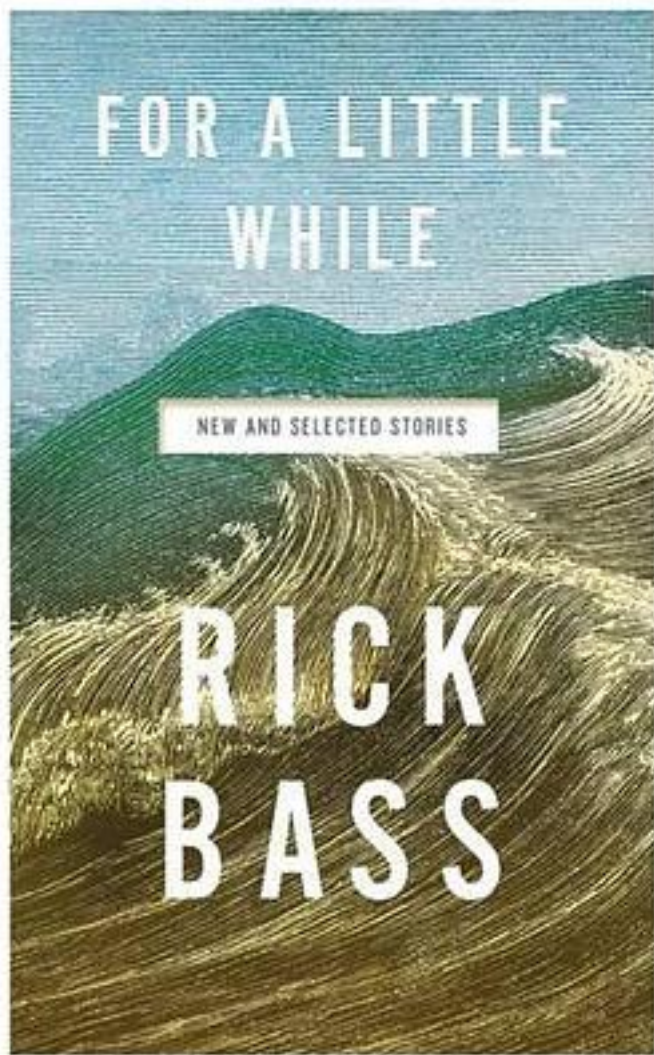


For a Little While
