

They deal with many diverse topics, yet they all share an underlying theme: the journey into adulthood. * "Children of Lir" puts a mystical twist on the traditional evil-stepmother fable. * "Deirdre of the Sorrows" questions whether one can change his/her destiny. * "Setanta" is the name of a young boy who wishes to become a member of the famous Red Branch Knights of Ulster. * "The Salmon of Knowledge" gives Fionn, a prince in hiding, the ability to answer any question; it also allows him to return to his people. * "Fionn and the Dragon" tells how the prince proves his bravery and assumes his rightful place as leader of the Fianna. * "Oisín in Tír na n-Óg" tells of Fionn, who, even in a beautiful land of eternal youth, longs to return to his beloved Ireland. As children learn these Irish legends, they are certain to learn a thing or two about themselves as well.
