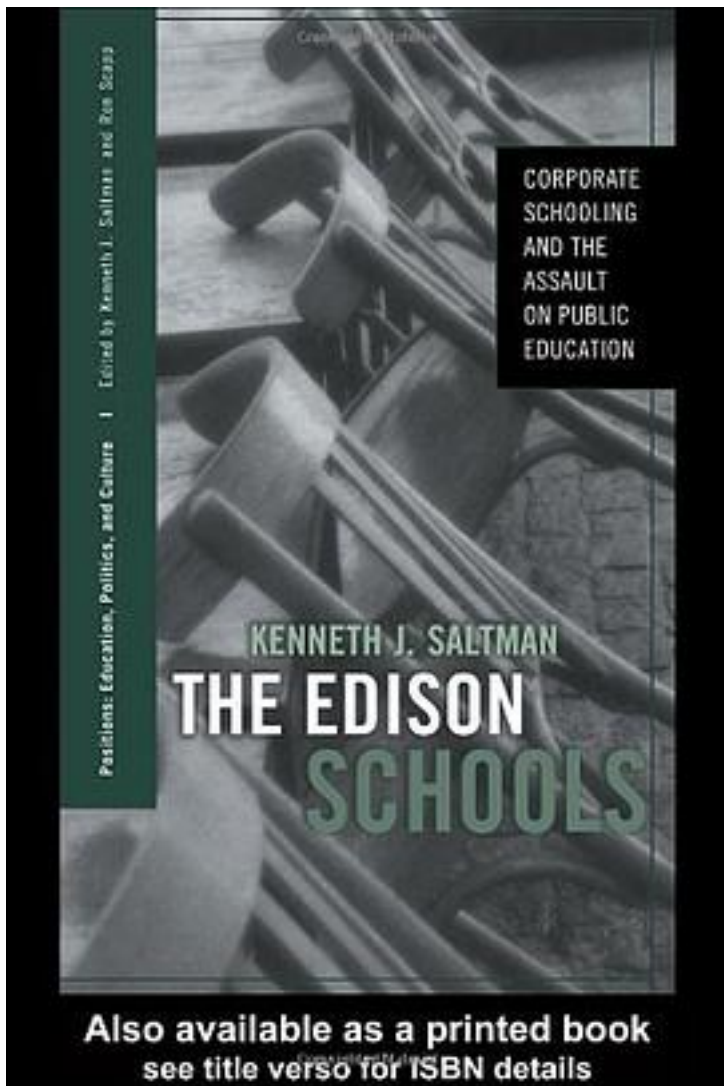

According to founder Chris Whittle, the popular press, and educational think-tanks, The Edison Schools were going to revolutionize American education.
