Sir John Hicks is one of the most important and influential economists of the twentieth century. Awarded the Nobel Prize for economics in 1972, he has made contributions across a wide range of economic theory, writing some twenty books. Arguably the most important of these, "Value and Capital", is seen as the roots of modern microeconomics and general equilibrium theory. Hicks possessed an unusual ability to synthesise the ideas of other economists - something that is evident in his invention of the 'IS-LM' diagram to expound Keynes' General Theory, and is perhaps what he is best known to present day economists for.
