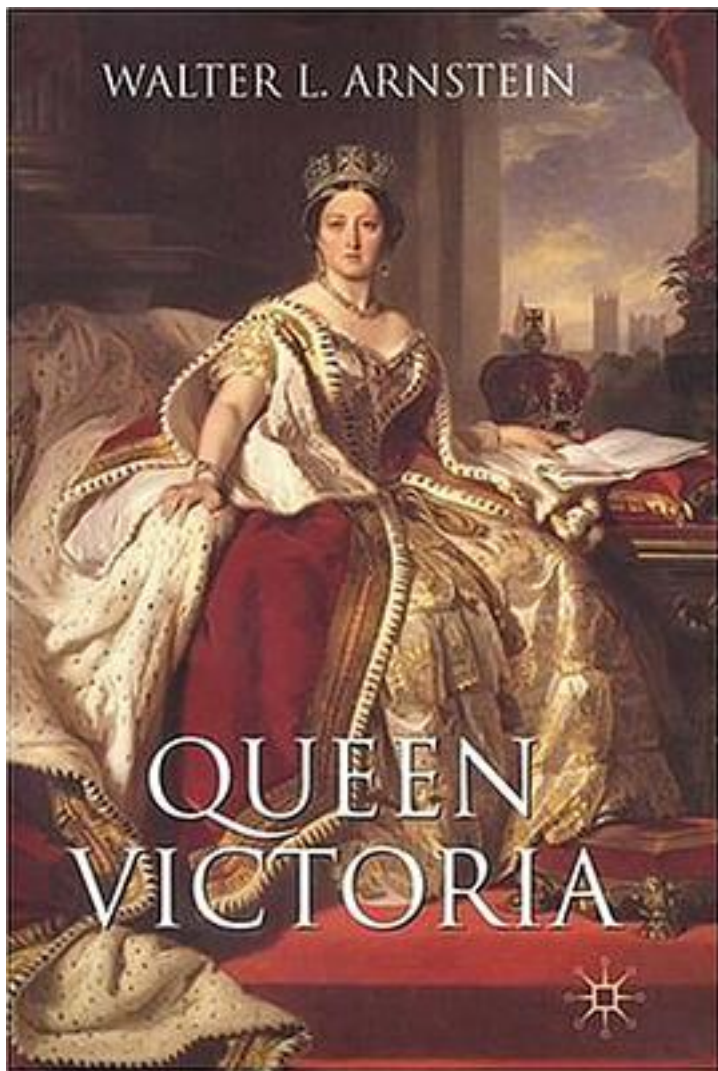

In this engaging study, Walter L.
