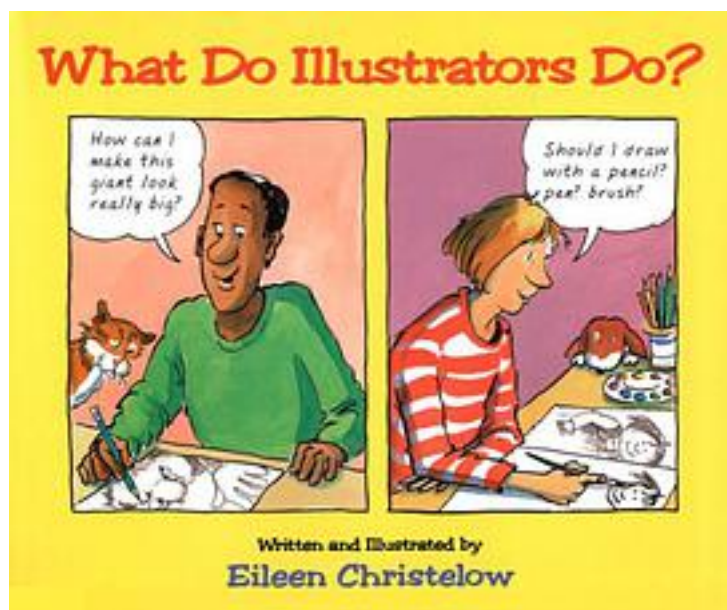


What Do Illustrators Do?
