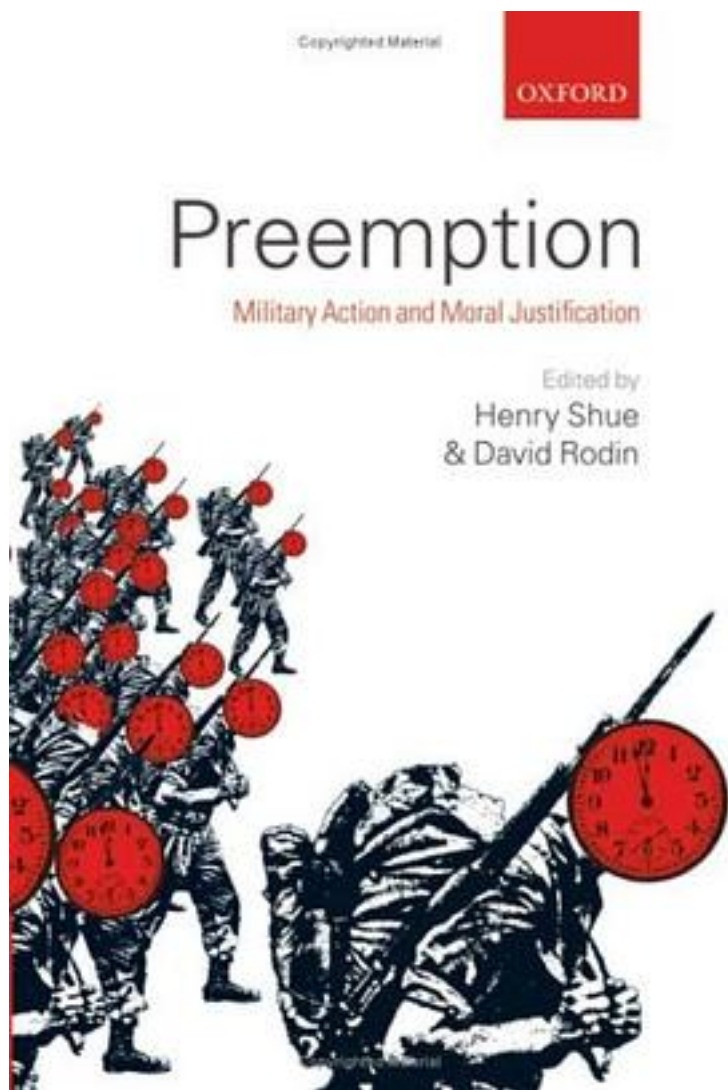


Preemption
