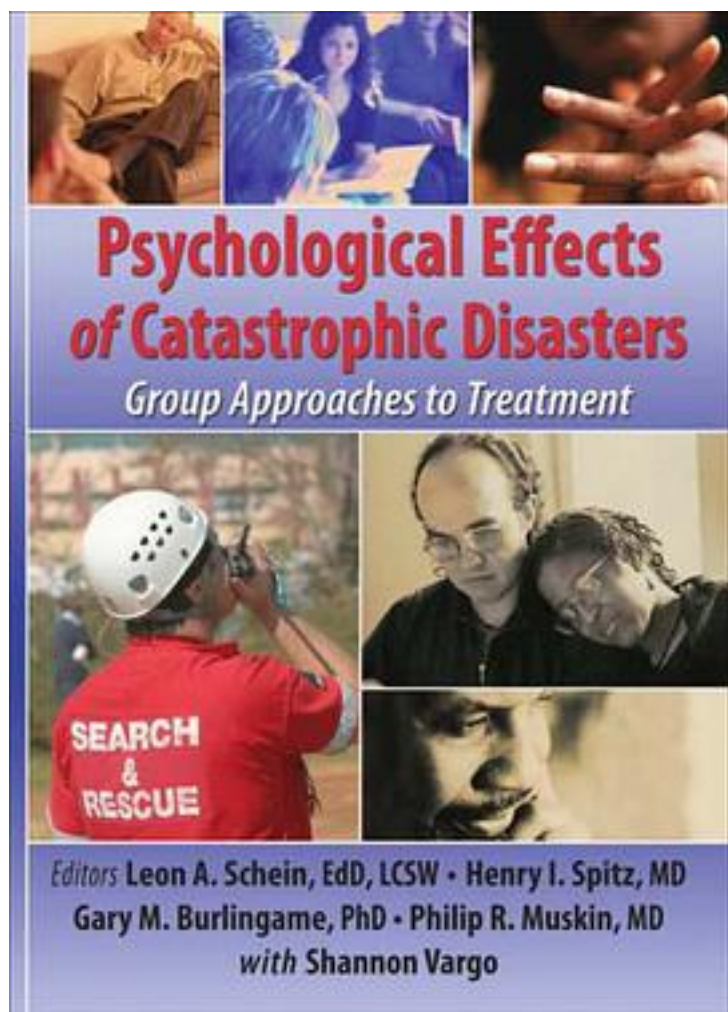


Psychological Effects of Catastrophic Disasters
