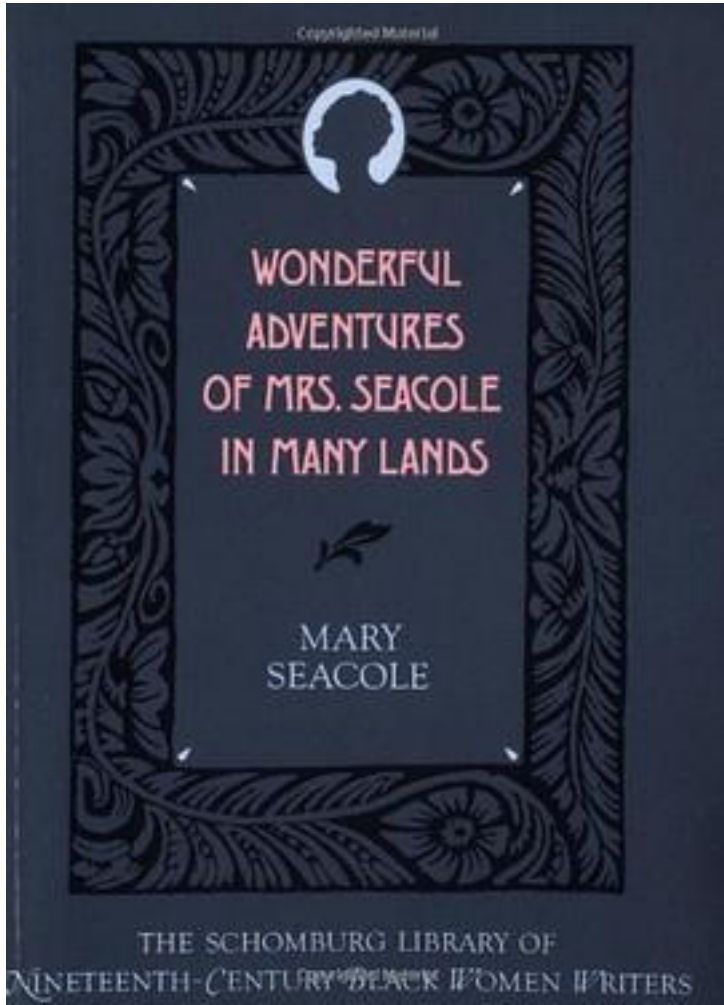

Mary Seacole was born a free black woman in Jamaica in the early nineteenth century.
