

An enduring classic in speculative fiction and the reported inspiration for the original comic hero, Superman, "Gladiator" is a melancholic tale of a boy set apart because of his unique gift and his lifelong struggle to come to terms with it. Philip Wylie (1902-71) wrote several classic works of speculative fiction, including "When Worlds Collide", available in the "Bison Frontiers of Imagination" series. Janny Wurts is the acclaimed author of many novels, including "Peril's Gate", from the "Wars of Light and Shadow" series, and "To Ride Hell's Chasm". She is the coauthor, along with Raymond Feist, of the internationally best-selling "Empire" trilogy.
