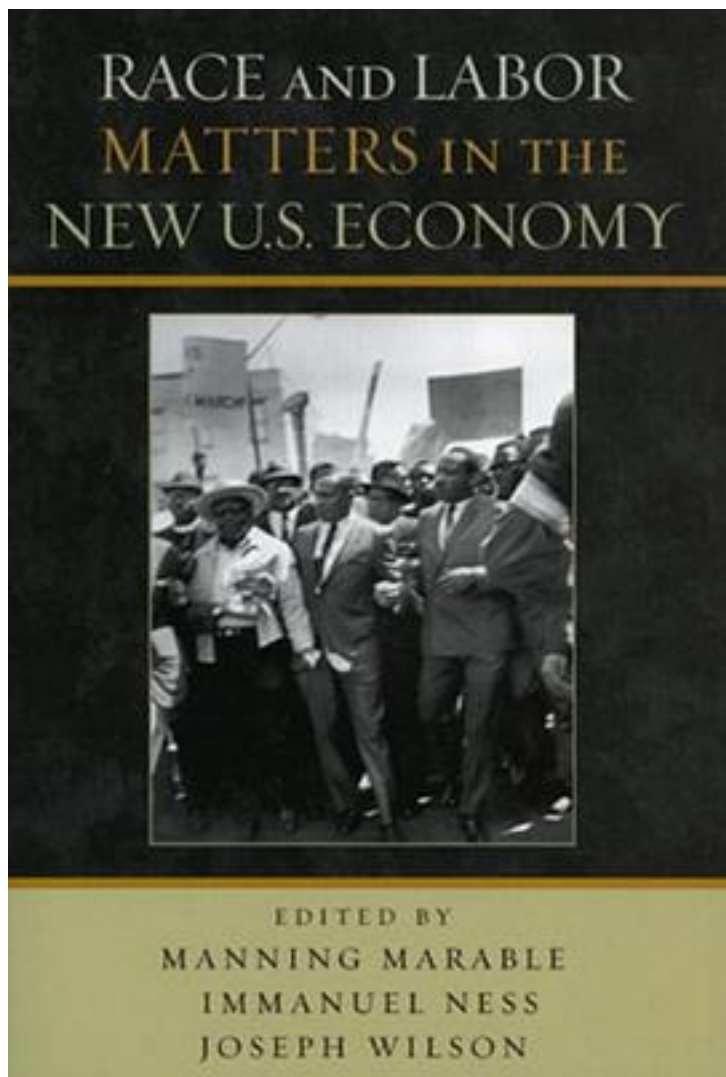


Race and Labor Matters in the New U.S. Economy
